

Our goal \$200,000

For decades, Horizon's Sackville Memorial Hospital (SMH) and its exceptional care team have been saving lives, healing the sick, and bringing comfort and hope to patients and families in their time of need – right here at home.

When you or your loved one needs surgery, complicated or not, you need peace of mind knowing our surgeons have the best tools to do their jobs.

The Sackville Memorial Hospital Foundation's **Operate with Surgical Precision Campaign 2021**, is aiming to raise over **\$200,000** to invest in specialized equipment that will elevate surgical and emergency care.

WHERE YOUR DONATION IS GOING

- **New overhead lights \$22,500**

Quality lighting plays an essential role in the success of the procedures performed in the operating room.

- **Anesthesia monitoring equipment \$41,000**

This state-of-the-art technology will provide the anesthesiologist with instant and vital information during surgery. This includes monitoring the patient's blood pressure, heart rate and oxygen level, as well as the brain's level of consciousness. This last feature will prevent over-sedation and will lead to faster wake-ups.

- **Sterilizer for medical device reprocessing \$42,000**

To avoid any risk of infection by a contaminated device, reusable devices undergo "reprocessing," a detailed, multi-step process to clean and then disinfect or sterilize them.

- **Laparoscopic/arthroscopic tower (camera and monitor) \$67,000**

This cutting-edge camera offers sharper images that provide truer-to-life clarity and colour, giving surgeons a better look at the fine details – so important during minimally invasive surgical procedures.

- In addition to the items for the surgical program, a **cardiac telemetry system \$22,000** – a way to monitor a patient's cardiac rhythm remotely and during any patient activity – will also be acquired for the Emergency Department.

Although the equipment we are using right now is fully operational, meeting our needs and completely safe, it is essential that it be replaced to keep up with developing technology.

ABOUT OUR DAY SURGERY PROGRAM

The SMH is renowned for its outstanding Day Surgery Program offering over 40 different types of surgeries including: arthroscopic repair of ACL, knees and shoulder procedures (Ortho), breast reduction and augmentation, carpal tunnel repair (Plastics), cystoscopy, urinary incontinence repair (Urology), tubal ligation and hysteroscopy (Gynecology), hernia repair, varicose veins stripping, lumpectomy, and gallbladder removal (General & Vascular).



Did you know?

Over 800 surgical procedures were performed last year at the SMH, which due to Covid-19, was lower than usual.
